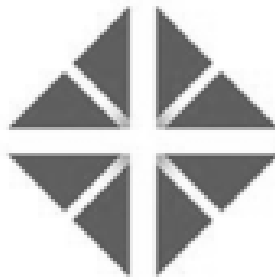
**FAVORITE HYMN** – Please contact Halyna if you would like a favorite/special hymn played at any of the services. Thank you.
